

Paris: Arts Capital of the World - and HSD Researchers were upfront!

HSD's joint research project BKKB („Bildkompetenz in der kulturellen Bildung“), conducted together with the German Institute for International Educational Research (DIPF, Frankfurt/Main), is attracting more and more attention, even beyond the boundaries of German specialists in art education. Therefore HSD researchers **Ulrich Frick** and **Miles Tallon** were invited to give an „*Interim Report on the German Approach to Quantitative Assessment of Visual Literacy*“ (for more information see <http://envil.eu/category/results/>) during the 2018 conference of the European Network for Visual Literacy (ENViL).



The conference was set under the heading „*Competencies in Art Education: Structure, Assessment and Assignment in Diverse Educational Contexts*“ and was hosted by the renowned Université Paris 1, Panthéon Sorbonne, and the leading french academia ESPE (École supérieure du professorat et de l'éducation) de l'Académie de Paris, on 12th and 13th of March 2018. HSD was invited to deliver a presentation at the concluding plenary session of the conference.

Frick and Tallon were able to present a multitude of generic task structures developed for the assessment of visual literacy, and they illustrated these generic tasks by demonstrating concrete test items for 9th and 10th graders which currently are in their empirical testing period until summer 2018.
